**Workshop Overview:** This interactive workshop supports and inspires therapists (clinical social workers play therapists, and counselors) to think creatively as they provide play therapy services for children and adolescents using the cognitive behavioral therapy model. The model is useful for working with young clients who are being treated for a variety of clinical symptoms such as anxiety, depression, adjustment problems, and trauma. Therapists working with children and adolescents will explore creative cognitive techniques using a variety of play therapy interventions: clinical tools, common children's board games, books, many free resources and inexpensive materials. The play therapy strategies, games, books, and activities presented in the workshop will support and enhance the delivery of the cognitive behavioral therapy model and provide therapeutic benefits for children and adolescents.

**Workshop Learning Objectives:** Participants will:

1. identify the benefits of using the cognitive behavioral therapy model with young clients in play therapy sessions.>
2. identify the benefits of using materials they have on hand, can make, or can get for little or no money in a creative way to enhance their play therapy practice.>
3. identify useful materials specifically designed for use in cognitive behavioral therapy and ways to modify these materials to help young clients during play therapy sessions.
4. explore strategies, books, and games to enhance the delivery of cognitive behavioral therapy in their therapeutic work with children and adolescents in play therapy sessions.
