**Presenter:** Lecole Sanders is a licensed independent social worker- clinical practice in her own private practice, Sanders Family Counseling, LLC in Florence, SC. Lecole works with a variety of children & family issues in her practice and frequently uses play therapy techniques in her work. Two areas of clinical interest for Lecole are children on the Autism Spectrum, and children/ adolescents with concerns related to eating/ body image. She regularly works with children and their families who are experiencing difficulty related to these particular issues. Additionally, Lecole is a TF-CBT trained therapist, and works with children who have experienced a variety of traumatic events. Lecole is currently working on becoming credentialed as an Registered Play Therapist.

**Overview:** This interactive workshop supports and inspires therapists (counselors, school counselors, clinical social workers, therapists, etc.) to think creatively as they provide play therapy and/or counseling services for children who have experienced a traumatic event. Counselors working with children who have experienced trauma will explore play therapy techniques using children's board games, books, many free resources and inexpensive materials. All of these play therapy techniques encourage and provide therapeutic benefits for children who have experienced traumatic events in this experiential theory based workshop.

**Learning Objectives:** At the conclusion of this 4 contact hour workshop training participants will

1. Identify the benefits of using materials they have on hand, can make, or can get for little or no money in a creative way with clients who have experienced traumatic events;
2. Identify useful materials and ways to modify materials to help clients who have experienced trauma;
3. Explore play therapy strategies, books, and games to enhance the therapeutic work with children who have experienced traumatizing events.
