Purpose: This 6 hour workshop will provide master level and clinical social workers as well as therapists new to play therapy methods or wanting to refresh their techniques with a thorough review of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder based on DSM 5 criteria as well as a rich skill set to work with clients offering play therapy methods. Participants will leave having an understanding of ADHD and play therapy methods to utilize in the practice setting and also to share with parents for the home setting.



Learning Objectives:

1. Participants will develop an understanding of the DSM 5 criteria for Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder.
2. Participants will increase their skill set for diagnosing ADHD based on the listed DSM 5 Criteria and develop play therapy strategies for their work setting.
3. Participants will examine Play Therapy methods including an introduction to play therapy history and rationale for using play therapy.
4. Non-clinical social workers and therapists will explore play therapy methods that can assist with providing services to clients of various ages.
5. Participants will demonstrate how to utilize lego play therapy within the treatment setting.
6. Participants will explore and practice various play therapy skills they can begin using with clients immediately.
